### Please read the following tips before circulating petitions:

- The signers of a village petition must be registered voters of the village listed on the petition sheet and the district represented by the office involved.
- While it is not necessary for petition signers to sign their name exactly as it appears on their voter registration record, petition signers should be urged to follow this practice. It will assist in the verification of the signer's registration status, if necessary.
- A person is not permitted to sign a petition on behalf of another person.
- The circulator must complete the top portion of the petition before any voter may sign. The circulator must also present when a voter signs the petition. A circulator is not permitted to leave a petition unattended.
